POST ADMISSION ACTIVITIES AND GUIDELINES

(Important instructions for learners to follow – July 2024 session for Semester Programmes)

1. As your admission for July 2024 is confirmed by the University, the following may be noted:
2. You can download your IGNOU ID card yourself by visiting IGNOU Samarth Portal (Link: <https://ignou.samarth.edu.in/index.php/site/login>)
3. Your study material will be sent by IGNOU New Delhi. In case of delay you can refer the soft copy and download the same. Those who have opted soft copy and availed the fee discount, they will not get hard copy books. (Link to download Soft copy: <https://egyankosh.ac.in/handle/123456789/1>)
4. Regarding theory counselling classes/Practicals/Project, you will get the information from Study Centre / Regional Centre.
5. You may visit your Study Centre regarding Practical Classes, if applicable to your programme.
6. You need to submit assignments in September 2024. You can download the question paper from (<https://webservices.ignou.ac.in/assignments/>) and submit the hand-written assignments to the SC.
7. You are eligible to appear for Term-End Exam in December 2024. For that you need to submit exam form in September/October 2024. (Link <https://exam.ignou.ac.in/>)
8. Result can be expected in about 45 days onwards and can be checked at IGNOU website.
9. If not satisfied with exam result, then you can apply for re-evaluation online within 30 days from announcement of the result.
10. You are advised to check the IGNOU websites rcbangalore.ignou.ac.in (Regional Centre website) and www.ignou.ac.in (Main) regularly for latest updates.
11. If you have any doubt about your programme or any query, you can visit Study Centre as per your convenience during the working hours of the Study Centre.
