- 1. You can download your IGNOU ID card and Registration details yourself by visiting IGNOU Samarth Portal (Link: https://ignou.samarth.edu.in/index.php/site/login) and complete the programme with in validity time.
- Your study material will be sent by IGNOU New Delhi. In case of delay you can refer the soft copy and download the same (Link to download Soft copy: https://egyankosh.ac.in/handle/123456789/1).
 Those who have opted soft copy and availed the fee discount, they will not get hard copy of the Study Materials.

- 6. **ODL Mode Students**: You need to submit assignments in September to October 2025. You can download the question paper from (https://webservices.ignou.ac.in/assignments/) and submit the hand-written assignments to the Study Centre allotted to you by separate file for each subjects.
- 7. ONLINE Mode Students: You need to login LMS login credentials (https://lms.ignouonline.ac.in/) and download the assignment in the tab MY COURSES and select each subject have assignments. Then upload the scanned documents i.e. your details and Assignment Questions and written assignments in the LMS Portal separately in each subjects. If LMS Login credentials not received from COE, IGNOU Delhi. Then send an email coe@ignou.ac.in
- 8. You are eligible to appear for Term-End Exam in Dec. 2025. For that you need to submit exam form on 2nd week of September, 2025. (Link https://exam.ignou.ac.in/) OR if you are not able to attend December 2025 exam, then you can write the June 2026 Exam and register for the exam in the 2nd week of March 2026.
- 9. Result can be expected in about 45 days and can be checked at IGNOU website.
- 10. If not satisfied with exam result, you can apply for re-evaluation online within 30 days from the announcement of the result.
- 11. You are advised to check the IGNOU websites <u>rcbangalore.ignou.ac.in</u> (Regional Centre website) and <u>www.ignou.ac.in</u> (Main) regularly for latest updates so that you will not miss the important communication.
